

- Undergraduate students may declare a Minor Field of Study which will be listed on the student's academic record. Requirements may be satisfied by completing 18 or more credits in: (1) any one of the University-approved minors (see catalog for list); (2) a curriculum other than the student's major; or (3) related studies from more than one department under the sponsorship of a qualified faculty member.
- At least twelve of the eighteen credits required for the minor must be at the 200-level or above. A minimum average of 2.00 must be earned in the credits required for the minor.
- At least half of the credits required for a minor must be earned at the University of Rhode Island.
- No course may be used to apply to both the major and minor fields of study. Courses in general education may be used for the minor. Courses in the minor may not be taken under the pass-fail grading option.
- Application of a minor should be filed with the Dean's Office prior to applying for graduation but after receiving the signature of the appropriate department chair.
- Approval of a minor does not guarantee space in any course required for the minor.
